Our new and enhanced services will be provided by a nurse practitioner, mental health worker and program workers! This includes:

- Treatment & monitoring of illnesses
- Harm reduction supplies & overdose prevention (Naloxone)
- Prescription medications (no narcotics)
- Testing for STIs (Sexually Transmitted Infections)
- HIV & Hepatitis C testing
- Foot care & wound care
- Substance use counselling
- Emotional & crisis support
- Referrals to community supports, including housing resources
- Form assistance (government benefits, social assistance, I.D.)
- Referrals to healthcare providers
